The Good Careers Academy offers an array of short-term accredited training programs:

NURSE'S AIDE

Duration: 12 Weeks | Tuition: \$900 | Registration Fee: \$50

In this 12-week program, you will learn basic anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, infection control, safety and emergency procedures, patients' rights, medical law, ethical treatment and patient care. The program can be a stepping stone toward a Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN) or a Registered Nurse (RN).

Upon successful course completion, you will receive CPR and First Aid certification, a Certificate of Completion and be prepared for entry-level employment in a medical facility. Additionally, you may be eligible to test for the State of Texas Nurse Aide certification exam.

MEDICAL ASSISTANT

Duration: 43 Weeks | Tuition: \$3,150 | Registration Fee: \$50

At the conclusion of this 43-week program you will be proficient in front office administration procedures, medical law and ethics, diagnostic equipment, anatomy and physiology, CPR and First Aid, injections, pharmacology, EKG, urinalysis, hematology and microbiology.

Upon successful course completion, you will receive CPR and First Aid certification, a Certificate of Completion and be prepared for entry-level employment in a clinical/medical health facility. Additionally, you may be eligible to test for the Registered Medical Assistant national certification exam

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN

Duration: 43 Weeks | Tuition: \$3,150 | Registration Fee: \$50

In this 43-week program, you will learn about fundamentals of emergencies, safety and hazardous materials, infection control, trade and generic medications, pharmacy law and record keeping. Additionally, you will participate in an externship during the course, applying the skills you have learned.

Upon successful course completion, you will receive a Certificate of Completion and be prepared for entry-level employment in a retail, hospital or institutional setting. Additionally, you will be eligible for the State Board of Pharmacy exam.

ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT

Duration: 24 Weeks | Tuition: \$1,150 | Registration Fee: \$50

At the conclusion of this 24-week program you will be proficient in Microsoft® Office Suite, QuickBooks™, verbal and written communication, office management, supply management and much more. You will also participate in a 6-week externship during the course, applying the skills you have learned.

Upon successful course completion, you will receive a Certificate of Completion and be prepared for entry-level employment in any industry.

APARTMENT MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

Duration: 10 Weeks | Tuition: \$500 | Registration Fee: \$50

In this 10-week program, you will receive instruction into maintenance and repair, concentrating on electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

Upon successful course completion, you will receive a Certificate of Completion and be prepared for entry-level employment within an apartment complex. Additionally, you may be eligible for the Certificate for Apartment Maintenance Technicians (CAMT).



COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE (CDL)

Duration: 6 Weeks | Tuition: \$4,450 | Registration Fee: \$50

In this this 6-week program you will receive instruction needed to obtain a Texas CDL, including preparation for a written and hands-on pre-trip inspection, writing and driving exam. Additionally, you will have hands-on experience with over the road driving, blind side parallel and alley parking, coupling/uncoupling and much more.

Upon successful course completion, you will receive a Certificate of Completion and may be eligible to test for the State of Texas Class A CDL license.


ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL PROGRAMS

- Proof of High School Diploma or GED
- Valid Texas ID or Texas Drivers License
- Immunization (if applicable)
- Other requirements may be required depending on the program
- Proper identification showing eligibility and authorization to work in the United States is required
